1 OUT OF 4 IRVINE HOMES LIST-INGS DISTRESSED • About 1 in 4 homes listed for sale in Irvine is a foreclosure or short sale, according to a report by Steven Thomas of Altera Real Estate. This is a slight decrease from

Thomas' last report on April 30, when nearly 30 percent of listings were distressed. According to Thomas' newest report, as of June 11, 2009:

591 properties were **listed for sale.** 155 of those properties were either foreclosures or short sales.

That means 26.2 percent of Irvine listings are distressed properties.

Countywide, distressed properties make up 32.9 percent of all listings, down from 35.9% six weeks ago.

NEW OFFICE BUILDING SOLD AT 40% DISCOUNT • Maguire Properties Inc. recently sold a new Irvine office building for about \$160 million, an estimated 40 percent discount off the construction cost, according to The Wall Street Journal. The building, at 3161 Michelson Drive, was completed in 2007 and has leased about 60 percent of units. It was originally slated to be anchored by New Century Financial Corp., a now-defunct subprime mortgage lender. The 19-story building was purchased by the Emmes Group, a privately owned real estate investment company.
